There is a <u>limited</u> number of student success awards available. Priority is given to pre-licensure nursing students.

- C. What impact do you hope to make in your native community?
- D. Include any professional, community service, or student nurse association activity involvement. Indicate awards, accomplishments, research, or volunteer projects you are engaged in.
- E. Letter of Recommendation
 - Letter of recommendation from a current Nursing School Faculty on an official school letterhead (one recommendation, please).
